VATICAN'S DECLARATION ON HUMAN DIGNITY (APRIL 08, 2024)

№ 47. The Church consistently reminds us that "the dignity of every human being... is valid from the moment of conception until natural death.... On account of the intangible value of human life, the Church's magisterium has always spoken out against abortion. In this regard, Pope St. John Paul II writes: "Among all the crimes which can be committed against life, procured abortion has characteristics making it particularly serious and deplorable. But today, in many people's consciences, the perception of its gravity has become progressively obscured. The acceptance of abortion in the popular mind, in behavior, and even in law itself is a telling sign of an extremely dangerous crisis of the moral sense, which is becoming more and more incapable of distinguishing between good and evil, even when the fundamental right to life is at stake. Given such a grave situation, we need now more than ever to have the courage to look the truth in the eye and to call things by their proper name, without yielding to convenient compromises or to the temptation of self-deception. In this regard, the reproach of the Prophet is extremely straightforward: Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness' (Is. 5:20). Especially in the case of abortion, there is a widespread use of ambiguous terminology, such as 'interruption of pregnancy,' which tends to hide abortion's true nature and to attenuate [or diminish] its seriousness in public opinion. Perhaps this linguistic phenomenon is itself a symptom of an uneasiness of conscience. But no word has the power to change the reality of things: procured abortion is the deliberate and direct killing, by whatever means it is carried out, of a human being in the initial phase of his or her existence, extending from conception to birth." Unborn children are, thus, "the most defenseless and innocent among us. Nowadays, efforts are made to deny them their human dignity and to do with them whatever one pleases, taking their lives and passing laws preventing anyone from standing in the way of this." [90] It must, therefore, be stated with all force and clarity, even in our time, that "this defense of unborn life is closely linked to the defense of each and every other human right. It involves the conviction that a human being is always sacred and inviolable, in any situation and at every stage of development.

BISHOP ERIK T. POHLMEIER'S MESSAGE

I was deeply troubled to learn about the effort to amend the Florida Constitution to enshrine abortion. Now that the Florida Supreme Court has confirmed that the amendment will be on the November ballot, it's crucial for voters to reject this proposal.

Efforts are underway to educate the public about the risks of this amendment. The Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops stands united in opposing this disregard for life. More information will be provided as we work to inform voters about the dangers of this amendment.

The debate around abortion has persisted throughout my entire life. Personally, I have witnessed the



profound suffering of women who have chosen abortion. While society has a responsibility to support women and families, terminating a child's life never leads to a solution.

Key arguments promoting abortion often overlook a crucial point. Phrases like "abortion is healthcare" or "my body, my choice" ignore the fact that another life is at stake. Once a baby is conceived, there is another body to consider. It can never be considered healthcare when it results in the death of another person.

The lives of many mothers are complex, and the news of a pregnancy is not always met with joy. While we should strive to improve the lives of those who struggle, we must remember that the unborn child is never to blame.

In the coming months, there will be a significant amount of information about the "Amendment to Limit

Government Interference with Abortion." It's essential not to ignore this information and to understand what is being proposed. The title itself is misleading because the government should prioritize protecting life.

Lastly, we must recognize that this is also a spiritual battle. Any effort to end life must be resisted with prayer. Remember, God's strength and seek his grace. Only with the power of the Holy Spirit can we help shape our society to value the gift of new life.

The Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops filed a brief with the Florida Supreme Court that identified ways in which both the ballot title and the amendment language are misleading and fail to provide voters with the full impact of the amendment on existing Florida law.



KINDLY STAY AND SPEND TIME WITH THE LORD IN PRAYERFUL ADORATION

On Holy Thursday the LORD IN BLESSED SACRAMENT is taken in procession from the main Altar to another area of the Church that is suitable for prayer. THIS PROCESSION FROM THE MAIN ALTAR SYMBOLIZES THE MOVEMENT OF THE LORD JESUS TO THE GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, WHERE HE EXPERIENCES GREAT AGONY before His arrest and betrayal. The Roman Missal (the book containing the prescribed prayers, chants, and instructions for the celebration of Holy Mass) invites [and I strongly request] all to continue in adoration and prayer before the LORD IN BLESSED SACRAMENT during the night. This Sacred Tradition of ADORING OUR LORD IN THE BLESSED SACRAMENT ON HOLY THURSDAY is often called the "Night Watch" or "Gethsemane Watch" and recalls how OUR LORD JESUS invited His apostles to stay with Him while He prayed. He said to them, "My soul is very sorrowful, even to death; remain here, and watch" (Mark 14:34).



THE RITE OF ELECTION

The Rite of Election has a history that dates back to the introduction of Gentiles to Christianity as the Church expanded from its Jewish roots. Participants in the Rite of Election are unbaptized adults known as catechumens, which derives from a Greek word for "being instructed." The Rite of Election takes place each year on the First Sunday of Lent. Catechumens indicate their desire to join the Church by signing the Book of the Elect, giving them the title "members of the elect." The word "election" in this case has nothing to do with politics; rather, it is a discernment that God is present in the life of the catechumens and is inviting them into a fuller life of the sacraments. Celebration of the rite has two parts: a sending and a receiving. First, catechumens are sent by their parishes. This is a public pronouncement that they are ready to enter a covenant relationship through participation in the sacramental life of the Church. In the United States, this is done through their presentation to a bishop in a ceremony conducted at one or more parishes in a diocese. This is the first of many sending they will experience in their faith journey. Those who are sent can then be received. The bishop or auxiliary bishop of a diocese attends the Rite of Election, accepts the parish community's judgment, receives the catechumens and invites them to enter their names in the Book of the Elect.



FASTING AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT: Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting & abstinence for Catholics. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence from meat is binding upon all members of the Church from age 14 onwards. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "PASCHAL FAST" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.







SAINT PAUL THE APOSTLE (C.5 AD-64 OR 65 AD)

On January 25, we celebrate the Conversion of St. Paul. It is one of the great events of the early Church. As Saul he had persecuted Christians, but was converted when our Lord

appeared to him in His resurrected glory (Acts 9:1-9). From that point, he took the name Paul, and became the Apostle to the Gentiles, and labored and suffered a great deal to bring all peoples to CHRIST THE LORD!

The sufferings of Saint Paul endured for Christ's and our sake in his own words: "Are they ministers of Christ? (I am talking like an insane person.) I am still more, with far greater labors, far more imprisonments, far worse



beatings, and numerous brushes with death. Five times at the hands of the Jews I received forty lashes minus one. Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was stoned, three times I was shipwrecked, I passed a night and a day on the deep; on frequent journeys, in dangers

from rivers, dangers from robbers, dangers from my own race, dangers from Gentiles, dangers in the city, dangers in the wilderness, dangers at sea, dangers among false brothers; in toil and hardship, through many sleepless nights, through hunger and thirst, through frequent fastings, through cold and exposure. And apart from these things, there is the daily pressure upon me of my anxiety for all the churches (CORINTHIANS 11:23-28).

THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

Pray continually," Paul urged the Thessalonians. The early church took this one step further: continually make the sign of the cross because at its heart, the sign of the cross is a prayer.

"In all our travels and movements, in all our coming in and going out, in putting on our shoes, at the bath, at the table, in lighting our candles, in lying down, in sitting down, whatever employment occupies us, we mark our foreheads with the sign of the cross," wrote Tertullian (155–220AD). In the fourth century, St. John Chrysostom (347–407 AD) wrote, "Never leave home without making the sign of the cross."

The sign of the cross is a lesson in discipleship. St. Cyril of Jerusalem (313–386 AD), noted in his Catechetical Lectures, "Let us then not be ashamed to confess the Crucified. Be the cross our seal, made with boldness by our fingers on our brow and in everything; over the bread

we eat and the cups we drink, in our comings and in our goings out; before our sleep, when we lie down and when we awake; when we are traveling, and when we are at rest."

The making sign of the cross is a powerful act of daily prayer, dedication, and remembrance.

ICON OF THE SALUS POPULI ROMANI

(Protectress or more literally Health or Salvation of the Roman People)

Salus Populi Romani is a Roman Catholic title associated with the venerated image of the Virgin Mary in Rome. This Byzantine icon of the Madonna and Christ Child holding a Gospel book is kept in the Basilica of Saint Mary Major. After the Edict of Milan in 313 AD, the phrase Salus Populi Romani was sanctioned as a Marian title for the Blessed Virgin Mary during the time of the Constantine the great.

The image arrived in Rome in the year 590 AD during the reign of

Pope Gregory I. Pope Gregory XVI granted the image a Canonical Coronation on 15 August 1838 through the Papal bull *Cælestis Regina*. Pope Pius XII crowned the image again and ordered a public religious procession during the Marian year of 954.

The image is one of the "Luke images" believed to have been painted from real life by Saint Luke himself. According to the legend: After the Crucifixion, when Our Lady moved to the home of John the Apostle, she took with her a few personal belongings – among which was a table built by the Redeemer in the workshop of Saint Joseph. When pious virgins of Jerusalem prevailed upon St. Luke to paint a portrait of the Mother of God, it was on part of this table top that he memorialized her image. While applying his brush and paints, St. Luke listened carefully as the Mother of Jesus spoke of the life of her son, facts which the Evangelist later recorded in his Gospel. Legend also tells us that the painting remained in and around Jerusalem until it was discovered by Saint Helena in the 4th century. Together with other sacred relics, the painting was transported to Constantinople where her son, Emperor Constantine the Great, erected a church for its enthronement.

BLESSING OF THE HOME ON EPIPHANY



It has been a tradition in the Catholic Church to bless chalk at the Masses for Epiphany, and then use the blessed chalk as part of blessing one's home in the New Year. The home blessing can be done as follows: Using the blessed chalk, mark the current year and the initials of the Magi above the outside doorways of

your home. Place a cross between each of the letters. It should look something like this:

20 A C A M A B A 2 4

After completing the above markings, pray the following prayer:

MAY ALL WHO COME TO OUR HOME THIS YEAR
REJOICE TO FIND CHRIST LIVING AMONG US;
AND MAY WE SEEK AND SERVE, IN EVERYONE WE MEET,
THAT SAME JESUS WHO IS LORD OF ALL PEOPLE,
FOREVER AND EVER. AMEN.

The legendary names of the three Magi are: *Casper, Melchior, and Balthasar*. The initials $C * \mathcal{M} * \mathcal{B}$ also stand for the Latin words, "*Christus Mansionem Benedicat*" which means: "May Christ bless this house (dwelling)." The markings over the doors should be left all year round as a sign that yours is a Christian home.
