

SAINT PAUL THE APOSTLE (C.5 AD-64 OR 65 AD)

On January 25, we celebrate the Conversion of St. Paul. It is one of the great events of the early Church. As Saul he had persecuted Christians, but was converted when our Lord

appeared to him in His resurrected glory (Acts 9:1-9). From that point, he took the name Paul, and became the Apostle to the Gentiles, and labored and suffered a great deal to bring all peoples to CHRIST THE LORD!

The sufferings of Saint Paul endured for Christ's and our sake in his own words: "Are they ministers of Christ? (I am talking like an insane person.) I am still more, with far greater labors, far more imprisonments, far worse



beatings, and numerous brushes with death. Five times at the hands of the Jews I received forty lashes minus one. Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was stoned, three times I was shipwrecked, I passed a night and a day on the deep; on frequent journeys, in dangers

from rivers, dangers from robbers, dangers from my own race, dangers from Gentiles, dangers in the city, dangers in the wilderness, dangers at sea, dangers among false brothers; in toil and hardship, through many sleepless nights, through hunger and thirst, through frequent fastings, through cold and exposure. And apart from these things, there is the daily pressure upon me of my anxiety for all the churches (CORINTHIANS 11:23-28).

A DAY OF PRAYER AND PENANCE

FOR THE LEGAL PROTECTION OF PRE-BORN CHILDREN

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court legalized abortion throughout the United States in its companion decisions Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton. Since that time, millions of children have lost their lives, and millions of women and families have been wounded by abortion.

On June 24, 2022, the Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization decision overturned Roe v. Wade, and we praise God for the great opportunity state and federal legislators now have to protect pre-born children. While God, in His mercy, ended the nearly fifty-year nationwide regime of abortion on demand, right now state and federal laws, in many instances, are still hostile to pre-born children. So, great prayer and advocacy is very needed.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), no. 373, designates January 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance,



called the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children" and states: *In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.*

THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

Pray continually," Paul urged the Thessalonians. The early church took this one step further: continually make the sign of the cross because at its heart, the sign of the cross is a prayer.

"In all our travels and movements, in all our coming in and going out, in putting on our shoes, at the bath, at the table, in lighting our candles, in lying down, in sitting down, whatever employment occupies us, we mark our foreheads with the sign of the cross," wrote Tertullian (155–220AD). In the fourth century, St. John Chrysostom (347–407 AD) wrote, "Never leave home without making the sign of the cross."

The sign of the cross is a lesson in discipleship. St. Cyril of Jerusalem (313–386 AD), noted in his Catechetical Lectures, "Let us then not be ashamed to confess the Crucified. Be the cross our seal, made with boldness by our fingers on our brow and in everything; over the bread

we eat and the cups we drink, in our comings and in our goings out; before our sleep, when we lie down and when we awake; when we are traveling, and when we are at rest."

The making sign of the cross is a powerful act of daily prayer, dedication, and remembrance.

ICON OF THE SALUS POPULI ROMANI

(Protectress or more literally Health or Salvation of the Roman People)

Salus Populi Romani is a Roman Catholic title associated with the venerated image of the Virgin Mary in Rome. This Byzantine icon of the Madonna and Christ Child holding a Gospel book is kept in the Basilica of Saint Mary Major. After the Edict of Milan in 313 AD, the phrase Salus Populi Romani was sanctioned as a Marian title for the Blessed Virgin Mary during the time of the Constantine the great.

The image arrived in Rome in the year 590 AD during the reign of

Pope Gregory I. Pope Gregory XVI granted the image a Canonical Coronation on 15 August 1838 through the Papal bull *Cælestis Regina*. Pope Pius XII crowned the image again and ordered a public religious procession during the Marian year of 954.

The image is one of the "Luke images" believed to have been painted from real life by Saint Luke himself. According to the legend: After the Crucifixion, when Our Lady moved to the home of John the Apostle, she took with her a few personal belongings – among which was a table built by the Redeemer in the workshop of Saint Joseph. When pious virgins of Jerusalem prevailed upon St. Luke to paint a portrait of the Mother of God, it was on part of this table top that he memorialized her image. While applying his brush and paints, St. Luke listened carefully as the Mother of Jesus spoke of the life of her son, facts which the Evangelist later recorded in his Gospel. Legend also tells us that the painting remained in and around Jerusalem until it was discovered by Saint Helena in the 4th century. Together with other sacred relics, the painting was transported to Constantinople where her son, Emperor Constantine the Great, erected a church for its enthronement.

BLESSING OF THE HOME ON EPIPHANY



It has been a tradition in the Catholic Church to bless chalk at the Masses for Epiphany, and then use the blessed chalk as part of blessing one's home in the New Year. The home blessing can be done as follows: Using the blessed chalk, mark the current year and the initials of the Magi above the outside doorways of

your home. Place a cross between each of the letters. It should look something like this:

20 A C A M A B A 2 4

After completing the above markings, pray the following prayer:

MAY ALL WHO COME TO OUR HOME THIS YEAR
REJOICE TO FIND CHRIST LIVING AMONG US;
AND MAY WE SEEK AND SERVE, IN EVERYONE WE MEET,
THAT SAME JESUS WHO IS LORD OF ALL PEOPLE,
FOREVER AND EVER. AMEN.

The legendary names of the three Magi are: *Casper, Melchior, and Balthasar*. The initials $C * \mathcal{M} * \mathcal{B}$ also stand for the Latin words, "*Christus Mansionem Benedicat*" which means: "May Christ bless this house (dwelling)." The markings over the doors should be left all year round as a sign that yours is a Christian home.
